A Titus 2 Woman: **Read Titus 2:3-5**

(* denotes suggested word study)

1. Who is she?

The older women...(we are all older than someone else!)

2. What kind of woman is she?

They be in behavior as becomes *holiness...(*reverent and *devout),

not *false accusers...(*slanderers),

not given to much wine...(*enslaved),

teachers of good things...(to give good *counsel and to be teachers of what is right and *noble),

that they may *teach...(*wisely *train).

3. Who are they to train?

The younger women.

4. What are they to teach?

To be *sound minded...(train to cause to be of sound mind, sound judgment and *prudent; to recall to one's senses)

To *love their husbands...(*kind, *affectionate, to be his friend and lover)

To *love their children...(fond of one's children)

To be *discreet...(*self-controlled, showing good *discernment)

To be *chaste...(*clean, *pure, *modest)

To be *keepers of the home...(domestically inclined, a good *housekeeper; keeper at home, to keep the home a *safe place)

*Good...(*beneficial in its effect)

*Subject to their own husbands...(to place oneself under his *authority)
